

St Paul's Cathedral is offering singing assemblies designed for singing in bubbles – for use in the classroom or hall, depending on your school's risk assessment. Each assembly will introduce a key Christian festival or season, teach a great hymn, unpacking how to read notation, and conclude with a singalong with the Vicars Choral of St Paul's.

We understand the difficulties around facilitating school singing at the moment, but believe that great singing in school begins in each class. We hope that schools can return to collective sung worship as soon as possible, but that even after that takes place, these videos will continue to be welcome singing resources – for bubbles, or indeed at home. Please feel free to share our videos with your community.

- We will introduce musical and religious concepts, including notation, with curriculum links to RE and music
- Our hymns are grounded in the catholic tradition of the church, and are for everyone. We believe they represent good music and theology, and are worth learning
- We will send participating schools a link to a YouTube video, which can then be used at a date and time of your choosing, as part of your whole school worship
- Liturgical reflections will be led by Dr Paula Gooder, Chancellor, with music led by Tom Daggett, Music Department, and sung by the Vicars Choral
